I'm going to read it in English and then I'll read it in Hebrew and it's actually very beautiful, it's very quantum

I like to share with people that Jesus taught in parables

Are you guys ok with that?

Because He says, "I teach in parables, and with parables I teach not."

So anything He shares, He shares in parables right?

And then He says, "The law, the psalms, and the prophets, the Old Testament Scriptures which obviously where we are in Genesis here, are types and shadows of good things to come, they're not the real thing, they're stories about the real thing."

And what is the real thing?

Hebrews 11 tells us what the real thing is -- it's spiritual, it's faith

So all of these stories are something that's happening inside of you

It's going from the flesh man and learning who you've always been which is Christ in you the hope of glory

So, all of these stories are about something spiritual that happens in you

Let me just read in English first

It says, In the beginning

And Hebrew reads from right to left and there's so much there

It's fascinating to me how we see nature, it says all nature speaks of Him in Scripture

When we look at nature we can see the resurrection, the life of Christ in us

And the sun rises where, the east or the west?

The East

And so guess what?

They read from right to left, right hemisphere to left hemisphere

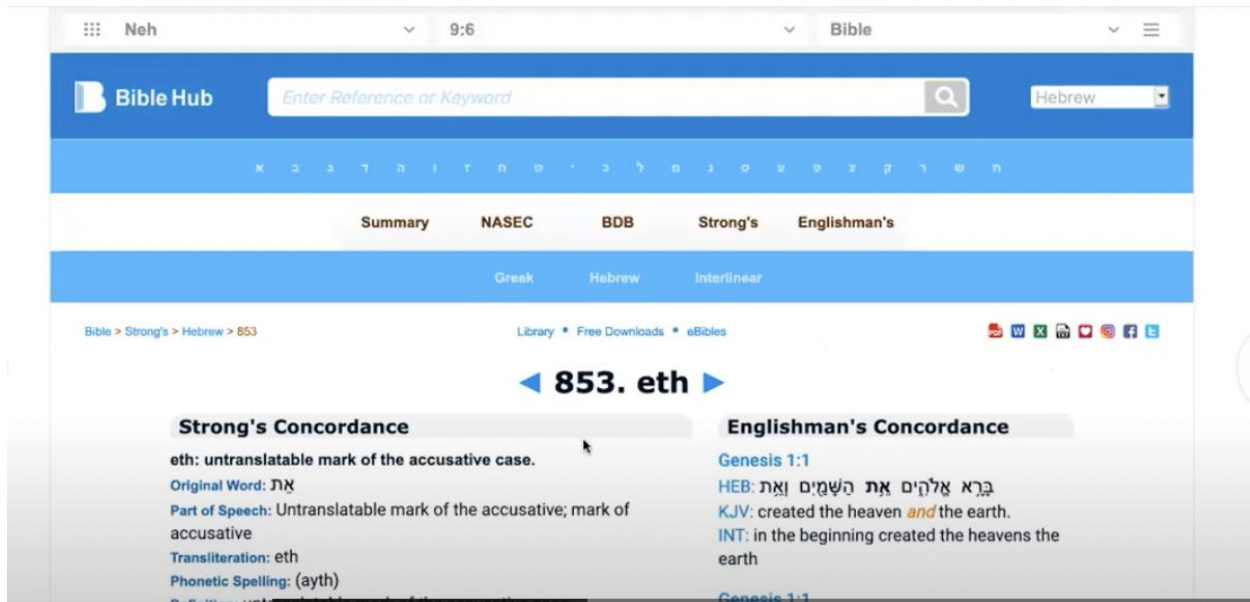
It's so beautiful how profound it is really

And so, In the beginning created God the heavens and the earth

We say, in the beginning God created the heavens and the earth

And Hebrew just has a little different sentence structure

So if you read it in English, whether KJV translation or whatever, they're just gonna leave this little word out -- and even if you click on Strongs it says untranslatable



It's very translatable actually

It's aleph tav - the beginning and the end

It's the first letter and the last letter of the Hebrew alphabet

So, I'm just going to start with the big picture first

It's seven letters **[I think he meant 7 words]**, so seven in Hebrew is always completion

The teleos, the telestai, the end, complete

And so from the beginning you're complete, everything's complete

And in the very center, in the very middle, is aleph tav

And we see at the end of Revelation he says, "I AM the beginning and the end, I AM the Alpha and Omega.

Now he didn't speak Greek, He spoke Aramaic and Hebrew so what he's saying is I AM the Aleph Tav

And that Aleph Tav is your I AM-ness or your awareness right in the very center of you

Now doesn't that sound like the parables of parables?

If you understand this parable, you're going to understand it, if you don't understand this parable, you're not going to understand any of the stories

And so He says, your heart is the soil, whatever you **???** you shall receive

Everybody ok so far?

Alright, so that's the teaching of teachings, the parables, of parables

So, let's go through *in the beginning* and let's just look at the Hebrew

This very first letter is *bet*

Bet is something that's inside, or the tabernacle, the house

So, it's the house of *resh yad mem*

Yad mem added to the end of any Hebrew word is just plural

This is how detailed I like to get -- this word is a preposition, a location, like in, on, before

And it's always good to go check the origin

So the Hebrew origin is *rosh* which means head

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So it says *inside (bet) the head.... Inside the heads*

That's the first word - it's a preposition

Second word - *bara*

If you hear someone say *bar* what does it mean?

For example: *Simon bar Jonah*

It means son of

So *bara* is *bet, resh, aleph*

Bar is son

Aleph is the very first letter in Hebrew, it means one, unity

And it's created by two *yads* which is the strength or power of God to do work

And in the middle is a *vav* which is a nail, or something that attaches itself to, or a man standing (like you or I)

Now, I'm going to do these first three words because you're going to need it

The third word is *Elohim* which is God, like *el (aleph lamed)* and *yod mem* again on the end which is plural

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And it literally means one God made of many parts (plural)

So, now this is where it gets fun

[back to the second word bara] Bet resh aleph

Bet is inside the tabernacle or inside you and I because we are the tabernacle of God, we are the house of God that was made not with human hands, it was woven, that seamless garment that you were wearing, the cross of humanity, that you will pick up everyday, was woven in your mothers womb, not by human hands

That's your tabernacle

Bet is inside

Resh is the head of a man

So, the head of a man within the tabernacle is *aleph*

Aleph is the power of God above and below

So, it's the power that takes the power from the spirit, within a man, and brings it to the earth below

Does this sound quantum or does this sound quantum?

So, it says *within the mind of man (bet), within the head of men (resh), Elohim (God) became one of many*

Isn't that what Jesus says? *You guys are My body*

And it says, What you do within, what the Son (*bar ra*) *ra* means to see or to rule

So *what you do within or what you see creates as Elohim*

Isn't that fascinating?

Now, *aleph tav* - the beginning and the end, I AM

I AM *aleph tav*, your own awareness is the beginning and the end, it's in the very center, the heart of hearts, it's your true identity

And it says *aleph* - the power above and below, a *vav* which is you -- you are the tabernacle of God

And to the Hebrews, they looked at the tabernacle like we see the tabernacle they created in Solomon's tabernacle, and you know all the different tabernacles, it was where God met man; it was where the spiritual meets the physical

And that happened in the holiest of holies -- you have that inner chamber, then you have the courts and the sea

And then we see this New Testament revelation that you are that tabernacle

So, He meets in the mind of man, but *aleph tav* means that it takes the power of God in the spiritual in man and brings it to the physical

And *tav* is the last letter, it's the picture of a covenant, a mark, a sign, or a cross, and it says, "what you do in the mind creates, and it takes the power above and below and attaches it to you, it binds two things together

Now what I love about quantum physics, because I have a science background is that's quantum

They don't know anything about Scripture but they can tell you how it works

I know Doc's trying to show that there's no difference

Science is catching up to Genesis 1

And we're trying to drag the church along with us because they're still trying to catch up

And now here's what's really interesting, so the heavens and the earth -- *Ha'shamayim v'et ha'eret*

So this word *v'et* is an *aleph tav* and then there's a *vav* in front of it

Vav is a man standing where heaven and earth meet

Doesn't that make sense? The heavens and the earth meet in man
 Because *vav* is a conjunction too, it joins two things together in Hebrew -- so it joins the thing in front of it to the thing behind it
 So, within your awareness, because I AM is *aleph tav*, we're going to take the spiritual and attach it to the earth
 Now we can dig into these words a little further too
 If we go to *ha'shamayim*....

It means the heavens or the sky
 And so remember to a Hebrew where the heavens met man was in the tabernacle
 The New Testament revelation is where God meets man is in you because you are the tabernacle, the house of God
 Heavens is *shamayim*
 The last two letters of this word are *yod mem* which again is just plural
Mem is the Hebrew letter for 40 and it's mighty waters, the deep waters
 What does that sound like?
 Sounds like you're spirit within right?
 The deep waters, the well within men, the spirit within man, the heart of hearts
 We see Jesus with the woman at the well, and He says, "If you knew who you were talking to, you would go within your own well and find it"
 The Hebrew letter before *mem* is *shin* which is El Shaddai, or a fire, or a tooth
 If you really look at the letter in Hebrew is like a fire, that fire comes in and completely wipes out everything in its path and brings it down to pure energy - what was physical is now no longer there, it's just pure potential now
 Or it is a tooth -- like when we eat, we chew it, and bring it down to it's finest elements, which is pure energy and allows it to shape it back again into physical
 That's literally what *shem* means in Hebrew
 They had pictures to describe things
 So -- *you have within you the shin within you, in the deep well within you, the spirit within you, that you can consume anything you don't like, break it down into its finest particles of pure energy and reshape it into new life within the deep well within you*
 That's *shin* - the sky

So, back to the word *v'et* which is *aleph tav* with a *vet* at the beginning -- within your awareness of man, the *vav* of man, the heavens in our spirit, we can take anything in the physical, break it down to it's finest elements of pure energy and reshape it into something new

Doesn't that sound like the -- in the ark of the covenant is Aaron's rod, the almond tree, that looks dead but sheds new life?

That's the *shin* within us

Because *Yahweh* is *yod, hey, vav, hey* and literally in Hebrew is this --

Yod is the strength of the power of God,

Hey is an open window, to behold, or to look

So literally in Hebrew, *Yahweh* is the power of God, that when we look at something, we get to choose whatever that window is (there's nothing in that window, it's a blank window)

But literally in Hebrew it means *the potential to take anything you see and bring it into the physical*

Vav is attaching two things, the thing in the front and the back

Meaning -- *Yahweh is the power of God that what we see attaches ourselves to what we see*

If that's not quantum I don't know what is

And that's *Yahweh* -- I AM the Lord is what it says, you're own awareness is *Yahweh*

Now why is the *shin* in there?

Because all of us have used our imagination and thought about things we don't want

And I realize that I used my imagination to create something I really didn't want to create

Well everything that is created is within God, it's in the container of God

He gave us a *shin*

And all the *shin* is, is *Yeshua* - Jesus is salvation

He added a *shin* to *Yahweh*

Why?

Because we realize things, and then repent, deciding not to do that

And we can look at what we do desire, instead of what we created, and it completely burns it up

We die to that old thing, it breaks it down into pure energy and resurrects to what we see

That's *shin* - that's *Yeshua*

Judas is in the garden and he sees Jesus

He comes in darkness, which always means he doesn't know who he is, no revelation

And he says, "Where is Jesus?" Which literally means *where can I find salvation?*

And he hears this answer, "I AM Salvation."

right here in the middle of Geneses 1, *Aleph Tav* - I AM

I AM Salvation

And it says they all fell down in astonishment, so it says, they asked the question again, "Where is salvation?"

And He says, "I already told you, I AM He."

And it says he repented immediately, he laid down everything else and Jesus says, "Now that you've found Me, let go of everything else you don't want, and hold on to resurrection itself, hold on to what you do want."

That's pure quantum, that's pure spirit

So, heavens and the earth are connected in man

And if we look at earth in Hebrew, it is *ha'erets*

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And it's the earth or the land
Remember in the parable of parables, what is the earth or land?
It's the heart of man
The earth, land, sea or field is always man's heart
And He gives you know the four types of soil, and people get hung up on the bad soil
But I'm not interested in the bad soil, I just want to know what the good soil is
The good soil clings to the seed and holds on to it and brings a harvest
So the seeds are your thoughts
Ha'erezt is the power from above, He brings it to blow in the mind and pulls and hooks you to the harvest
Because this is the *aleph* again and it's the *yod* above and below a man
Man is the container of God that attaches the spiritual to the physical
So what you do in the heavens, what you do in your spiritual, the power of God above, we connect it to the land below, the earth below, within man
Within *resh* which is the head of a man
And this next letter is an interesting letter, it's *tsade*
If you look at the picture for the letter *tsade* it's actually a harvesting tool, which should really be interesting because of harvesting - *who will harvest the harvest of the land*
And in the heart what are we doing?
Here's the parable of parables -- whatever thoughts you plant in your heart will produce, you go to sleep, you don't have any power over this thing but it produces all on its own
We go to sleep and first the blade, then the ear, then the full corn -- but it will produce a harvest
So, it's interesting that the land, our soil, our heart, literally is -- *we take the power above and bring it into the physical within our minds*
And then the *tsade* is a picture of a farming instrument that harvests or a hooked man
It literally says -- *the seed that you plant in your heart hooks or draws you in harvest whatever you do in your mind.*
Quantum!

So let's just do this all, let's do it fast now
Ready?
Bereshit created Elohim Alef Tav the heavens and the earth -- *within the minds, what the son sees creates as God. And that God, that Alef Tav in the very center of you is your own I AM-*

ness. And what you do in the spirit, what you do in your head, within the mind of man, attaches you and harvests what you see in the physical.

That's Genesis 1:1

This is beautiful isn't it?

Doc: I knew you would bring this into a focus that we can actually see in the Scriptures that this is actually quantum.

Genesis 1, *I AM the beginning and the ends*

When you pay attention to creates and it's going to be that way from the beginning to the end It says *All are sons and daughters of Abraham* and then it says *the law was given 400 years later*

Now, this is really interesting

400, we think literal 400 but remember Jesus says these are types and shadows these are stories of good things to come that are going to give you the truth in faith, in spirit

In Hebrew 10 to 11

And so 400 was the last letter of the Hebrew alphabet which was *tav*

And he says this, *while the earth remains seedtime and harvest shall not cease*

So here's what he's saying -- *Your soul is going to be redeemed, it's eternal, it's perfect, from the beginning it's been created perfectly but while you're attached to humanity while you're attached to this cross of a human, this is going to be in place seedtime and harvest shall not cease. Alef Tav whatever you do within is what your life experience is going to be*

And even if you mess it up, Abraham's promise still remains, you're still My son, and your soul is going to be redeemed.

It's just fun when you dig into this

Every story will tell you the same story

The beginning from the end

So, let's do this -- dream a great dream

We've all done things with our life, or at least I have, I don't put you guys in my boat, but I'll just use me as an example

I've created things in my own heart that I wish I wouldn't have

Where I've focused on things and it becomes real to you

Guess what, we have a *shin* within us - our salvation is within

We can simply turn from that, picture what we do want and it'll actually consume everything we didn't want bring it down to pure spirit and recreate exactly what we have our attention on

That's *Yeshua* really in Hebrew

We see this in Elijah to Elisha

Elijah is the God of Yahweh

And the God of Yahweh is *yod hey vav hey*

And we know that everything that is that's ever been created is contained in the container of God Himself

Well, if we had to live with everything that our hearts and minds have created, and we couldn't change or free from our past, that wouldn't be that fun

But salvation goes from Elijah to Elisha - they add a *shin* to the name

The *shin* is -- this is my life right now, I've created this, let's say it could be anything

So he says where can I find salvation?

I AM your own awareness

Let's say someone is struggling financially

That's our physical man, our bank account tells us what it is, our emotions say this is who we are, but the spiritual man is supposed to reign, or Jacob was supposed to supplant what we see in the physical, supposed to supplant Esau

So let's turn from that, let's die to that

Let's see what we do want - seeing myself as *shalom*, whole, flowing, abundant, vibrant, healthy, joyful, my relations are intact

And if I stay my focus on that, that old me of lack literally gets burned up and consumed into pure spirit and resurrects to what I'm looking at

That's the *shin* in Hebrew

Yeshua -- I've given you salvation

You can choose to see what you want and if you're willing to stay here and keep focused on this, believe you have received, stay in that I AM that

The tense in Hebrew is really important

So the tense is never I'm praying for, or I'm going to be, or I'm praying through

It's I AM - present tense

Doc: Is everything present tense?

Mike: Everything

I AM

So you choose your own I AM-ness

No duality

Deb: That's like Richard Rohr's book *The Naked Now*

Mike: yes, very good

That's exactly what Dr Cecil is teaching you guys

It's quantum

Every story tells the same thing, there are no contradictions

It's just that we're reading it in English and we don't look at the allegory, we don't look at the story in it

So, if we look at it just as literal, we're probably going to miss it, because the letter kills but the spirit behind it is beautiful, it brings life

Just like in Genesis 1, when you really look at it

But everything tells you the same story

What you do in the spirit, I don't care what it is, what you choose to focus on will literally consume the old you, break it down to pure spiritual like a fire

It's really fascinating because when a forest fire comes through, it looks like death, like pure death

It's black with ashes and stuff

And then within the weak, there are these little green shoots start to come up

So it actually consumes everything was the picture (of the *shin*) to the Hebrew -- the fire, the purification of God is I don't want to be that man anymore, I'm going to choose to see myself as someone else, I'm not even going to focus on why this is over here

It literally consumes that old past, brings it into pure spirit and resurrects into the life we are focused on

That's the *yeshua*, *the shin* within

Doc: Now how does that dovetail into what you have really been focused on for some time - the prayer concepts that have been so many beautiful testimonies from you and your people that I have been truly, truly, inspired by

Mike: Thanks Doc, I'll tell you a great one

So, I'm a big sports nut. I have a Yankees game on now, even though they're getting beat I'm getting ready for service on Sat and I have the masters on, and I hear this voice, and I'm like, "I know that voice." And I look over and it's my friend from Los Angeles, and here's his testimony....

He hired an acting agent, one of the top talent agents in Los Angeles almost 3 years ago because he wanted to get into commercials and acting. And for 3 years it was no, no, no. He would audition, and interview, and still get turned down
And he was traditional prayer, as in "Lord please bless me if it be Your will."
This always keeps you in a state of asking if it be His will because that's your awareness
But then he told me that he began to take what I say for real
What does that mean?
He's praying FOR being a successful actor -- you will always be in a state of praying FOR, you'll never get there
So he decided to see himself as a successful actor -- believe you have received, you are in a present state - a successful actor
He changed his focus just a little bit
And we see in Scripture *I am the light*
It says everything else is a shadow, the spiritual is the real thing
What we do in the spirit is the real thing, and what we see out there is the shadow
If you have a flashlight and you change that light -- I AM, my awareness is the light also casts a different shadow out there doesn't it?
So, all he did is change his focus just a little bit
Here's how simple it was
He decided to see himself as a successful actor
And 1 John says this -- *This is the confidence we have in Him. According to His will He hears everything we say. And since we know He hears everything we say, we have what He heard me say.*
So, he goes, "I and my Father are one. So if I can hear myself in my imagination say something, I know the Father has heard me say it and it's going to be exactly as I heard myself say it.
So remember for 3 years he couldn't get an acting job -- but he closed his eyes, and for a week every day in his imagination he had this conversation with his wife like this -- "Hey babe, isn't it amazing I have a national commercial I'm in."
1 week!
His agen calls him and he says "You need to sit down, there is a national wireless carrier that wants to do a commercial with you in it. It will go across every medium."
And he shares this with me in March
All he did is in his imagination saw himself telling his wife that he was in a national commercial.
And he would feel the joy of that
It's an AT&T wireless commercial that is going across every medium, and it launched at the Masters (the biggest golf tournament).
All he did was change, I AM the light. My own awareness is Alef Tav is the very center of me.
What we do in there is what's causes the change
This whole world we see around us is just the shadow, it's not the real thing, spirit is the real thing.
He changed his focus, and instead of trying to become successful, he saw himself successful
How he did that was just by repeating a simple image in his mind
That's what he did... that's it.
1 week replaced 3 years of effort.

[Deb gave a testimony]

If we limit ourselves at all, we have limited Him
And our own I AM-ness is the only thing that limits anything
I'll share a testimony with my brother in law
And what really got me to go down this road was I went to Bible school and this woman had had her uterus removed
And in the African cultures where I went to Bible School, if you can't have kids it's a big deal
Often men leave their wives if they can't produce offspring
So this woman is crying and tells the pastor, "I want to have children, but my uterus has been removed."
And without skipping a beat, he says, "You need to make up your mind woman. Do you want a uterus or a baby. Who said you need a uterus to have a baby?"
And so she gave birth without a uterus
And then I was like, oh my gosh! See how we limit ourselves with the flesh man
She had her uterus removed but do we really believe all things are possible to him who believe?
Do we?
So that got me to go down that road.
And my brother in law was diagnosed with Waldenstrom's disease
And it's 100% fatal, it's never been cured ever in the history of this cancer
Except one now, and you can guess who that is
So he was diagnosed with it and no one has ever lived from it, but here's what he did -- he changed his focus
Let's change what we pay attention to and the physical will align right up with what the focus is because that's just the shadow
And so he saw himself walking his daughter (my sister in law was pregnant with their daughter at the time) down the aisle
That's it!
We didn't bind any cancer, we didn't rebuke anything, we didn't get a prayer team together
The more you rebuke stuff, the more you attach to it
And all he did was see himself walking his daughter down the aisle, and now he's the only survivor

So you see yourself Deb as this beautiful vibrant woman, and whatever you love to do whether it's kids or grandkids, just like Jesus said to Judas -- Now that you've found Me you've found salvation. So salvation for you in that situation is perfect health abounding around, and you drop everything else and just lay hold of Me.
